

Parent/Carer Communication Survey Feedback

You said...

That it could be very confusing when different staff use different methods of communication as messages may be missed.

That you would like more information about the learning that is taking place in school, so that parents/carers can offer additional support at home.

That you don't always feel that you have enough notice of events that are taking place in school or changes to the timetable.

So, we're going to...

Standardise communication across all classes so that:

- Weduc will be used to send out whole-school messages
- Class Dojo will be used for class-based information and messages from your child's class team

Adopt a whole-school approach to communication so that, as a minimum, parents/carers receive:

- A half-termly overview of the timetable containing information such as key dates, topics being explored and skills being developed etc.

Move forward by ensuring that all planned events are calendarised on the school website. Class teachers will also use Class Dojo to share reminders about whole-school events. We shall also be resuming class newsletters in September which will contain information specifically related to your child's class.
