Topic: Keeping Safe in the Community.

English

Class

To enhance our Keeping Safe in the community project we will use a range of fiction and nonfiction texts to look at the work of the emergency services. Examples of stories we will use are;
Burglar Bill

Cops and Robbers

Fireman Sam – Heroes of the storm.

We will also use a range of non-fiction/information texts.

Maths

Each child has their own maths targets in Number, Using and Applying and Shape, space and measure targets. We will focus on one of these areas each week, linking them to our topic work where we can and at other times teaching them discretely.

Our **ICT** will be linked to maths – we will be learning to make and read different graphs using the 'To count' programme.

Interoception - My Body

Zones of Regulation –We will be working with the Occupational Therapist to develop our understanding of emotions and feelings.

Dance – A specialist dance teacher will work with the children each week on fun dance activities.

Athletics – jumping, throwing and running.

Science

Our Bodies

We will be learning the names of more complex body parts such as knuckles and eyelashes.

We will also learn about our different senses and practice using each of them.

PSHE/Independence

Our focus this term will be on **dressing**. We will be learning/practicing how to turn our clothes the right way out, manipulating socks and gloves and practicing different fastenings such as zips and buttons

COOKING

This term we will be completing a range of cooking activities focusing on the skills of measuring quantities.

Creative/Art

We will be looking at how colour, shape, mood/emotion, size and form relate to different pieces of music

The World Around Us

We will be talking about different emergency services and how they help us. We will also be learning some basic first aid.

MY COMMUNITY.

We will continue with our monthly visits to the library so that we are getting out in the community.

MUSIC — we will all learn about rhythm and pulse and investigate using percussion instruments. Some children will learn to play the recorder.

Our art work will also be linked to music this half term.
