Aim of Programme:

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We intend to raise aspirations through exposure to a wide range of education and employment opportunities, which are embedded throughout our school curriculum. Students will experience a range of encounters. tailored to their individual needs and circumstances, including community facilities, employers and potential Post-16/19 settings, ensuring equal opportunities and inclusion. Advice and guidance will be provided throughout to support families in identifying the next best step.

Year 7 & 8

- Introduction to the world of work through work-based learning, visiting speakers and employer-set projects.
- Lessons within the curriculum support Preparing for Adulthood.

Year 10

- Scheduled college/provider visits are implemented to enable students, and parents, to make an informed decision.
- Continued skill development through a progressive careers and PFA curriculum.

Post 16 Transition

 Students and families are supported with the transition to their chosen Post 16 setting through a personalised transition plan which is likely to include supported visits, taster sessions and a transition planning meeting.

Post 19 Transition

- Students and families are supported with the transition to their chosen Post 19 setting through a personalised transition plan which is likely to include supported visits, taster sessions and a transition planning meeting.
- Halesbury supports parents and pupils with the transition from Children's Services to Adult Services.

Primary Phase

Early carers education may involve role play, dress up and visiting speakers.

Year 9

- Students receive personalised career guidance in order to begin exploring interests, strengths and potential opportunities.
- Continued skill development through a progressive careers and PFA curriculum.

Year 11

- Post 16 destinations are identified and students are supported throughout the application and consultation process.
- Opportunities for work experience, related to students interests, are implemented, where appropriate.

Post 16

- Pupils who are educated elsewhere for Post 16, receive regular, supportive phone calls from Mrs Harris.
- Pupils at Halesbury Post 16 benefit from experiencing a curriculum that is centered upon Preparing for Adulthood.
